FHCRC Web VPN Connection Options

There are two ways that one can connect to the FHCRC network via 'Web VPN'. Both options use the Cisco AnyConnect VPN client to do so. The common method is to use a web browser such as Internet Explorer or Firefox.

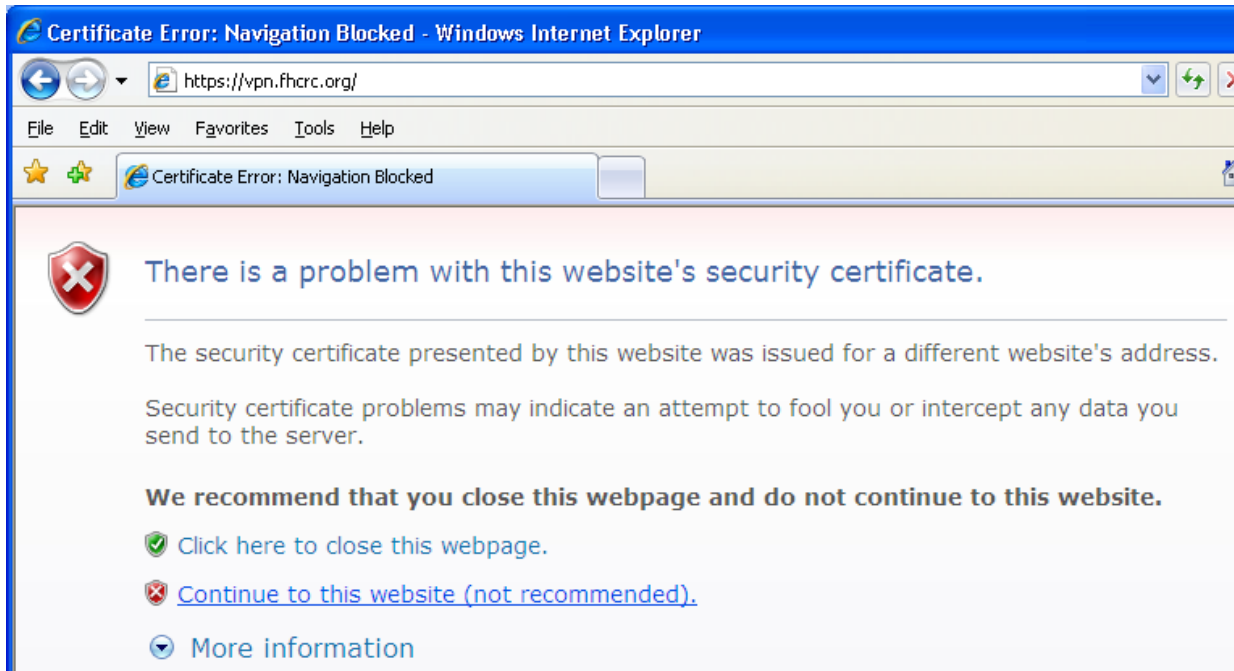
Connecting With VPN via Web Browser

The instructions below were created using Internet Explorer, but the experience will be similar using other browsers.

Open up your browser window and enter <https://vpn.fhcrc.org> for the URL address.

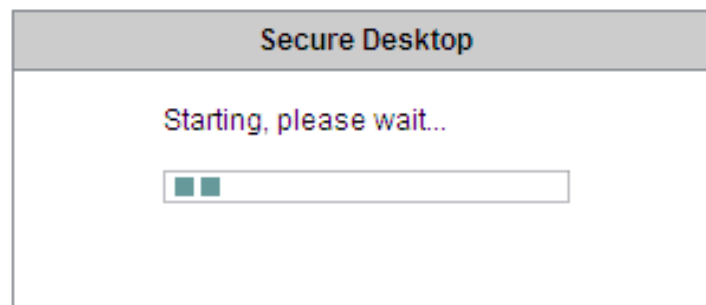


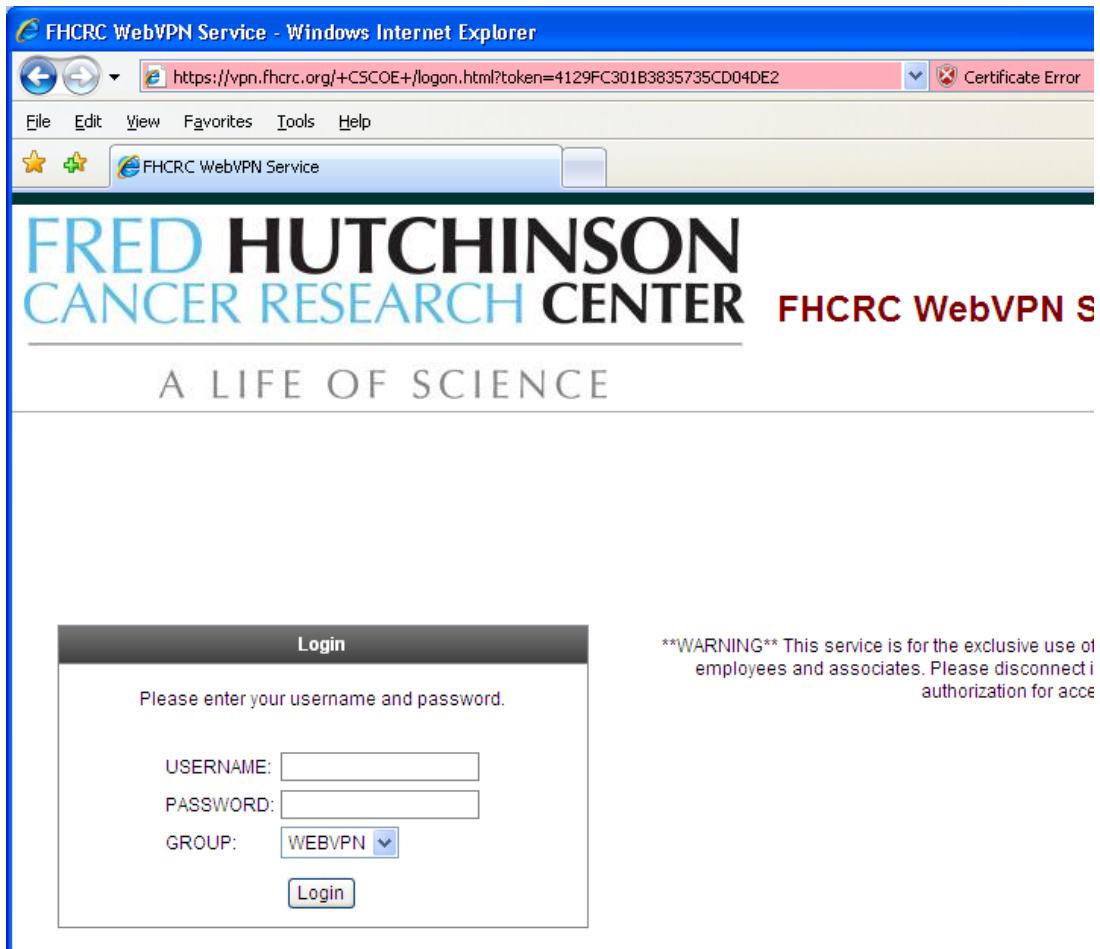
You may see the following warning:



Click on **'Continue to this website...'**

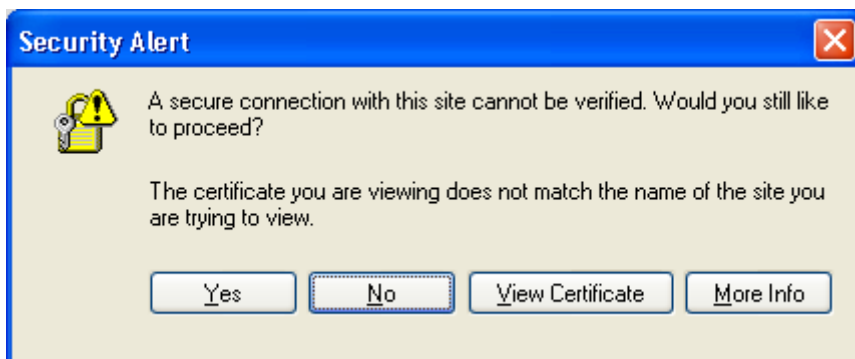
You will see the Secure Desktop 'Starting, please wait...' information box, followed by a prompt to enter your FHCRC username and password.



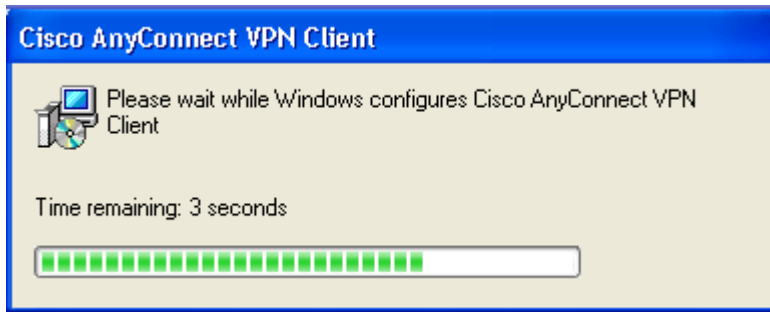


After entering your username and password, click on 'Login'.

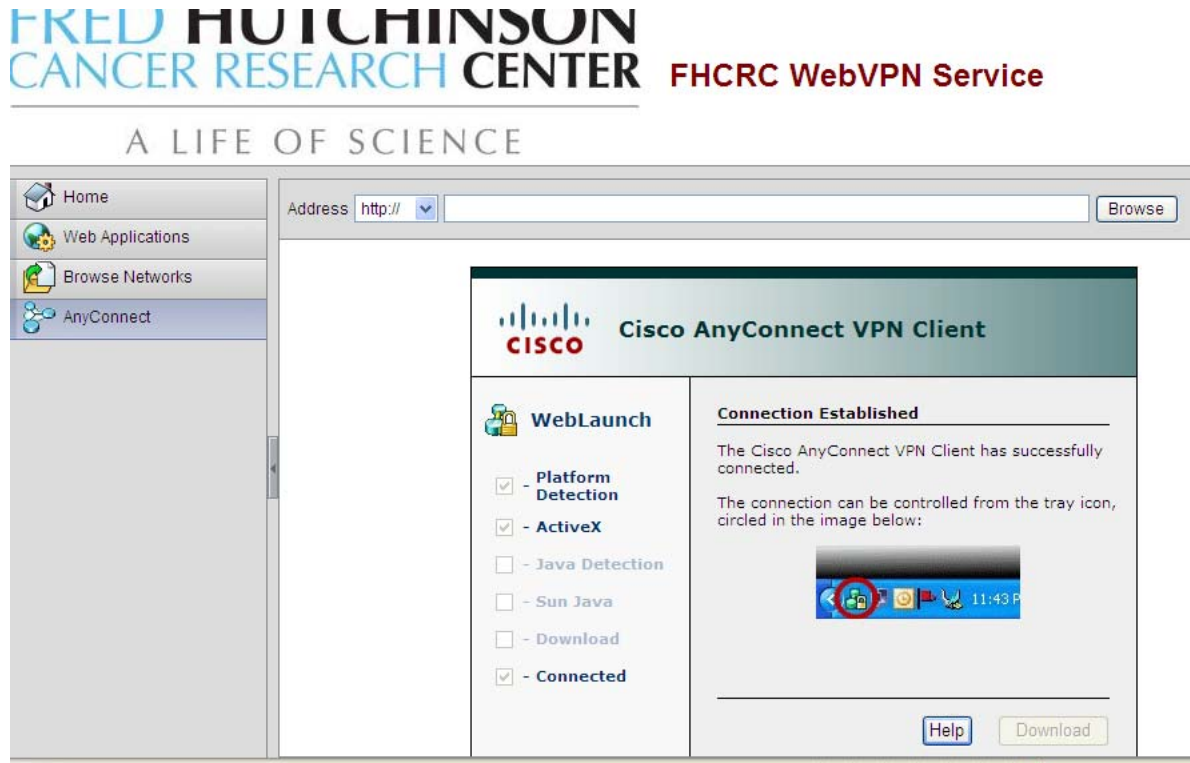
Accept any Active X components if prompted and accept any certificates offered to initiate the Cisco AnyConnect VPN software installation.



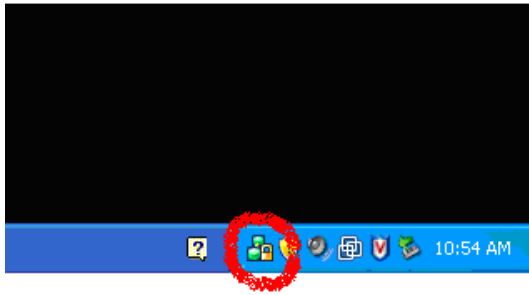
The AnyConnect software will begin to install.



Once the software installs you should see the following web page stating that you have successfully connected:

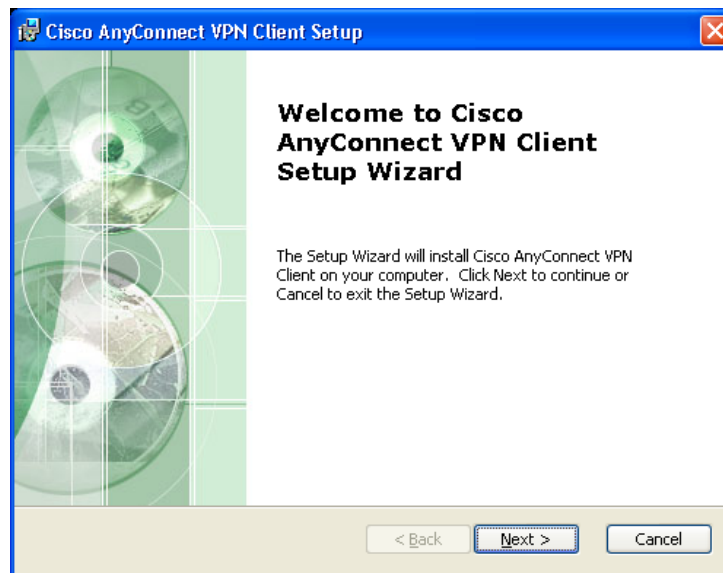


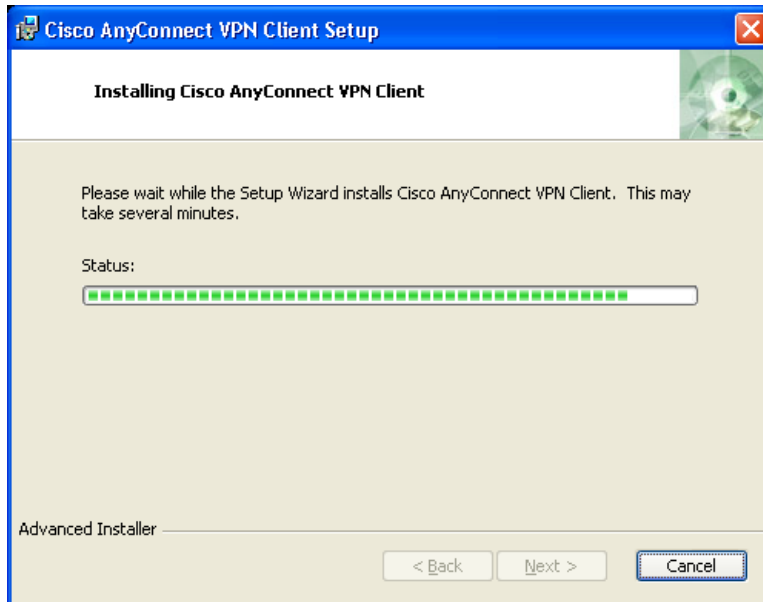
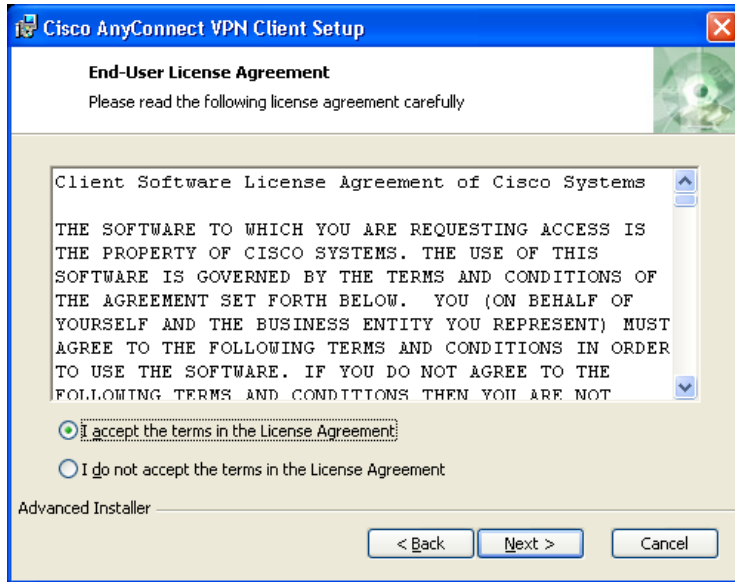
You should also see the 'VPN Lock Symbol' in the Windows taskbar indicating a VPN connection.

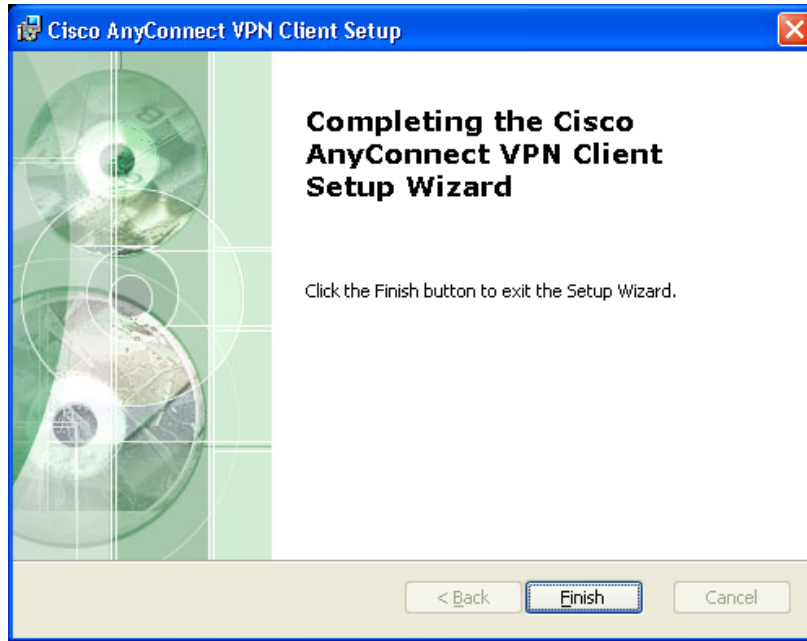


Manually Installing Cisco AnyConnect Software

Run the **CiscoAnyConnect-win-2.2.0136.msi** installer found in the **Web VPN\Cisco AnyConnect VPN** folder. Click 'Next', agree to the installation terms and follow the prompts.

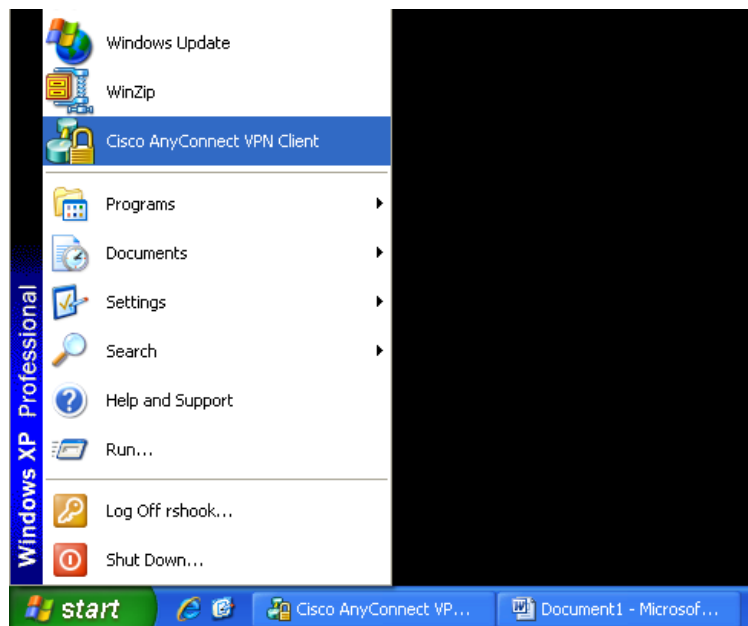




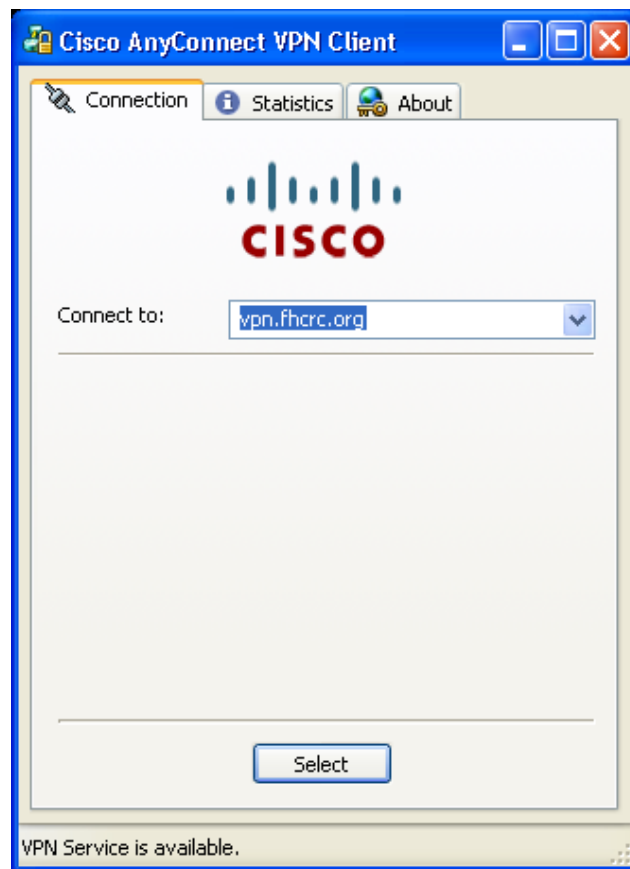


Connecting to the FHCRC Network

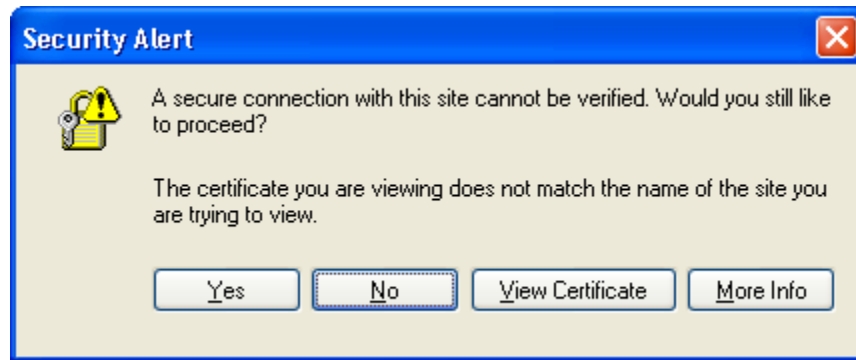
Click on the Windows 'Start' button, and select the **Cisco AnyConnect VPN** client.



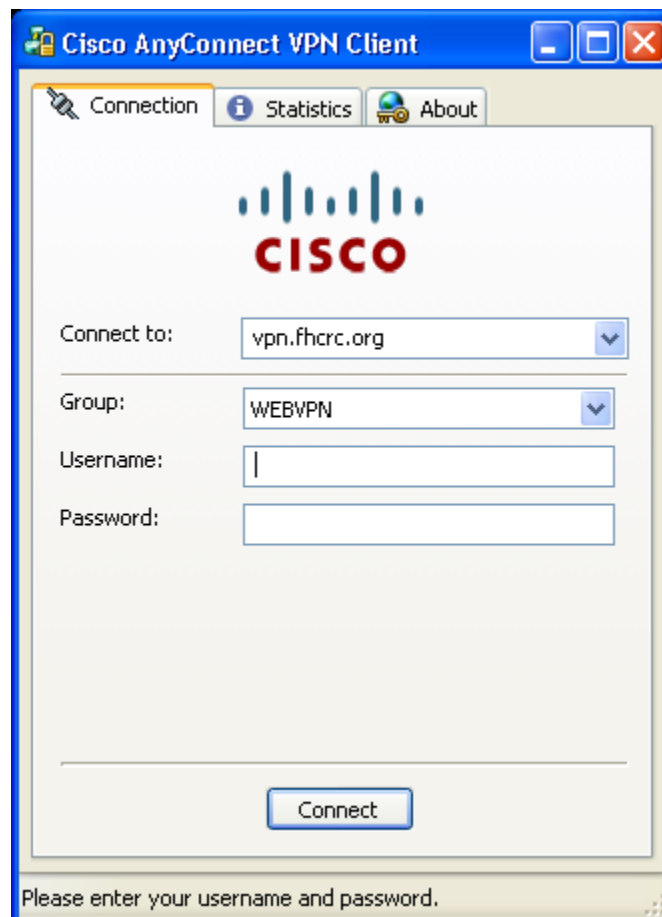
Enter **vpn.fhcr.org** in the 'Connect to:' field and click 'Select'.



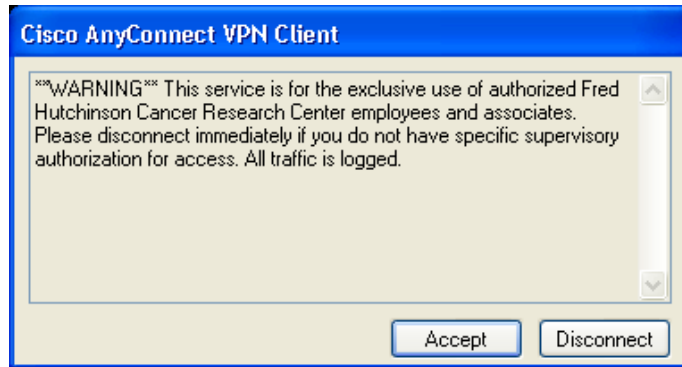
Click **'Yes'** when prompted to accept the certificate.



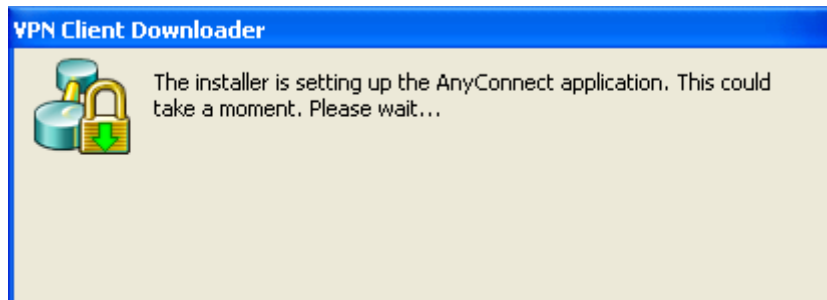
Enter your FHCRC username and password when prompted and click 'Connect'.



Click 'Accept' to agree to the terms of service.



The installer will set up the AnyConnect application.



The 'lock' symbol (circled here in red) confirms that you have successfully connected to the FHCRC network via WebVPN.
